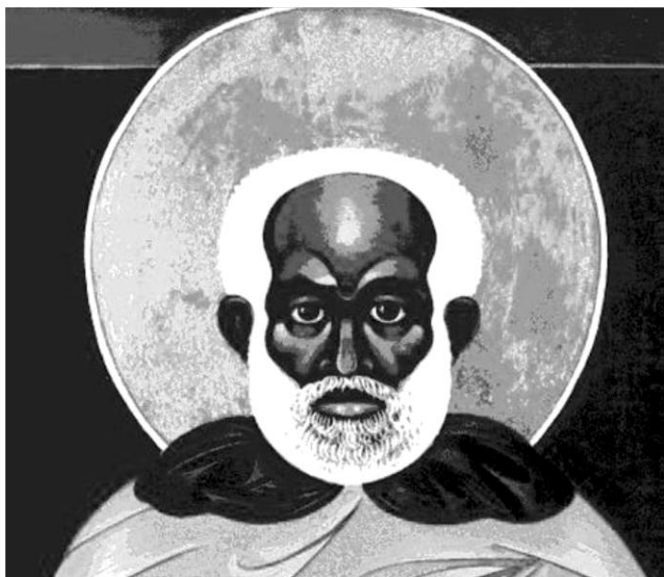
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St. Moses the Black, detail of contemporary icon.

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Psalm III

- ✘ Great are the works of the LORD, studied by all who delight in them.
- ✘ Full of honor and majesty is his work, and his righteousness endures forever.
- ✘ He has gained renown by his wonderful deeds; the LORD is gracious and merciful.
- ✘ He provides food for those who fear him; he is ever mindful of his covenant.
- ✘ He has shown his people the power of his works, in giving them the heritage of the nations.
- ✘ The works of his hands are faithful and just; all his precepts are trustworthy.
- ✘ They are established forever and ever, to be performed with faithfulness and uprightness.

- ✘ He sent redemption to his people; he has commanded his covenant forever. Holy and awesome is his name.
- ✘ The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all those who practice it have a good understanding. His praise endures forever.

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
