shalom to fulfillment.*

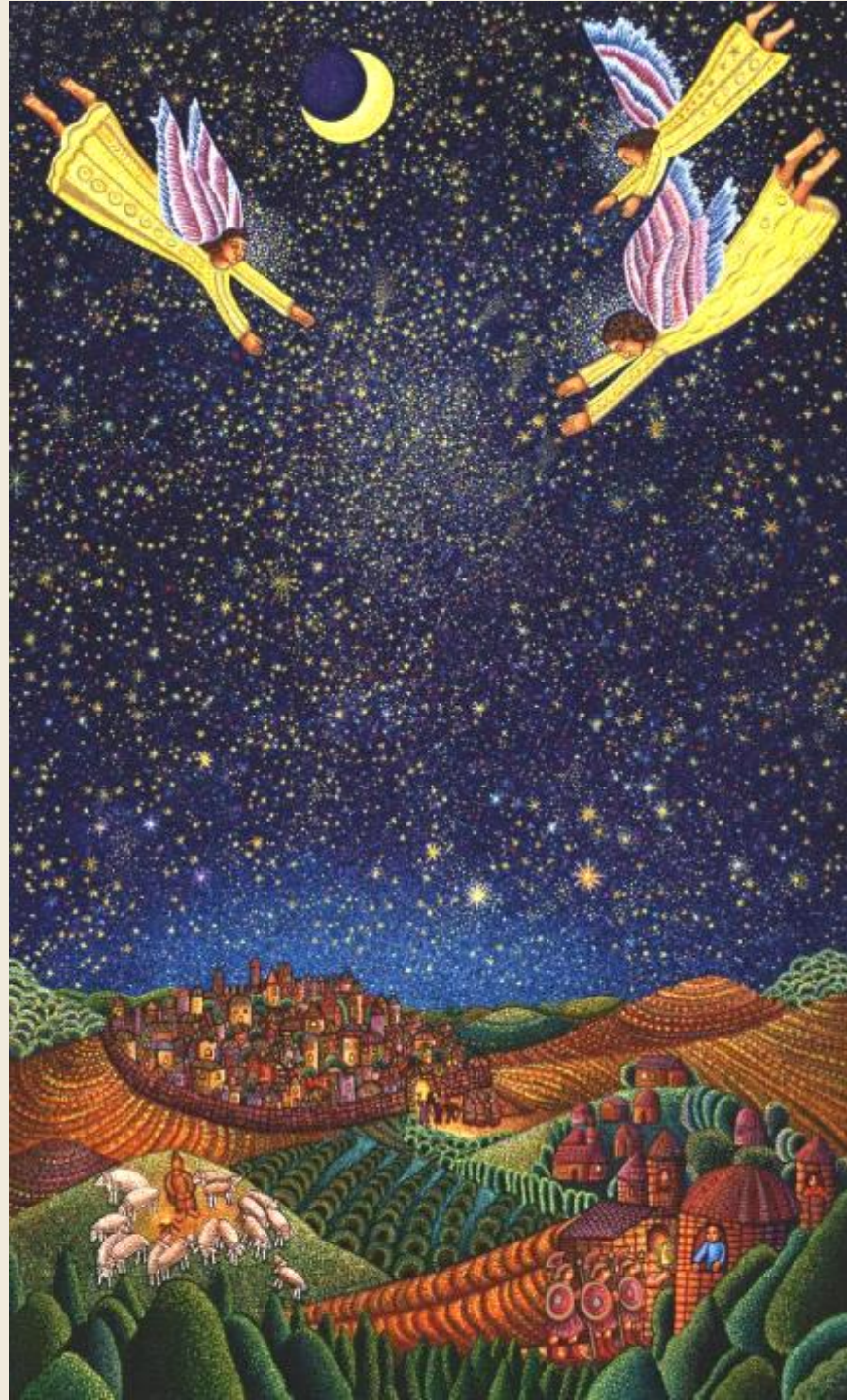
