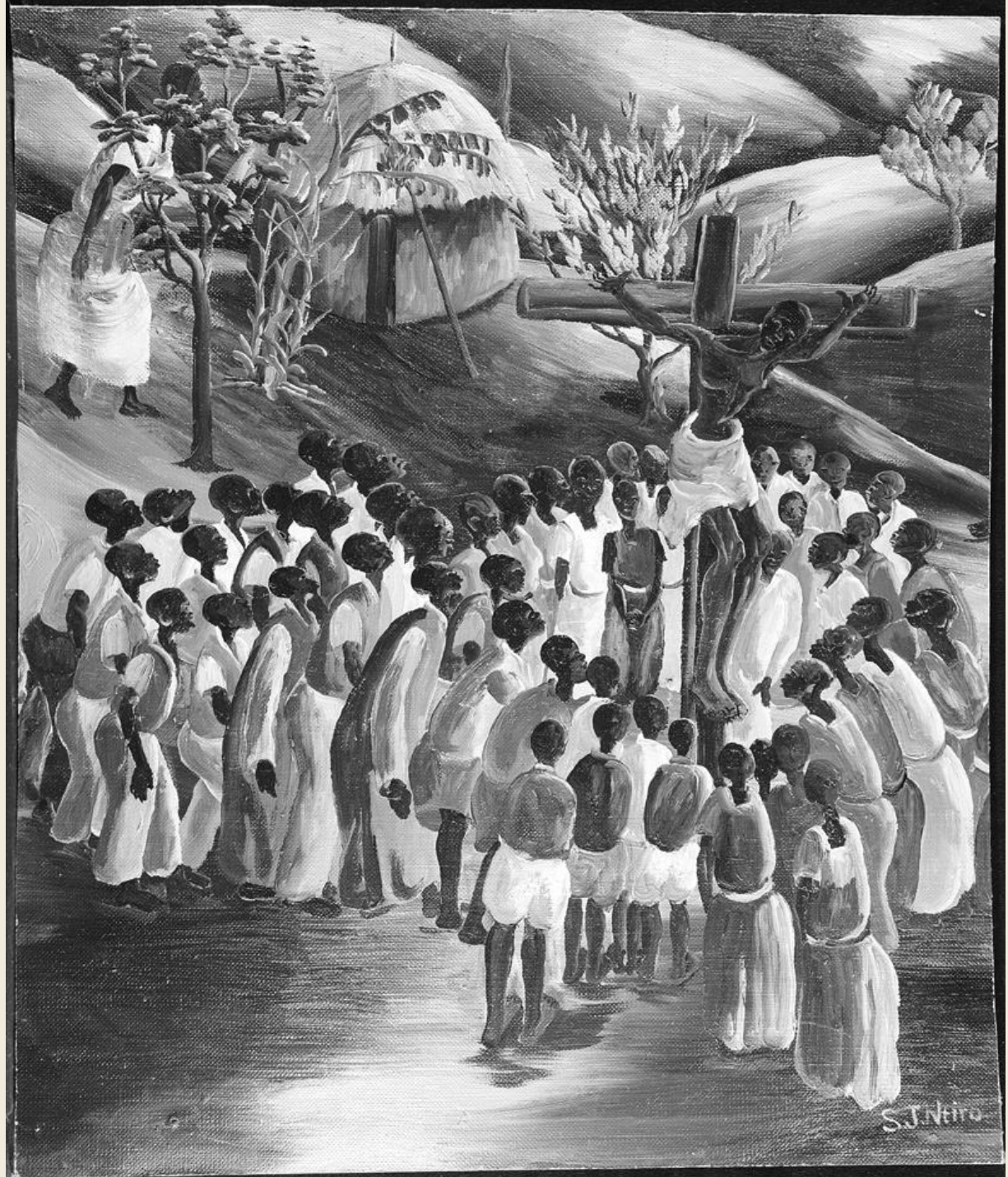
Good Friday, Year C
